1. Mathematics

You will have to focus on the following topic areas:

- Reducing fractions
- Transforming algebraic expressions
- Deriving straight line equations from two points
- Stating linear functions
- Solving quadratic equations
- etc.

In the entrance exam, various financial accounting questions will be asked on balance sheets and income statements. This may include questions on simple transactions and their impact on the balance sheet and income statement. Part of the exam may also include questions on management accounting. Exam topics will include:

- Understanding the purpose of balance sheets and income statements
- Formation of accounting records for frequently occurring transactions in a business environment
- Elementary legal regulations for financial accounting according to the Swiss Code of Obligations
- A basic understanding of the purpose of a business accounting system (BEBU)
